

Cyber relationship can be among people in different states, different countries, different sides of the world, or even people who reside in the same area but do not communicate in person.




Cyber Relationship

- a business partnership.





1. Online Dating

2.Virtual sex

- It refers to internet or cyber sex.
- Exchanging sexually explicit messages, pictures & videos over computers or cell phones is called virtual sex.
- It is not uncommon for people to send sexually explicit messages to each other. Sexting, phone sex, video sex, etc are very common today.

Roses are red, violets are blue, and romance scammers can fool you, too. Look for these red flags.




They say they're far away.
